




LEAD ABATEMENT

We received a **\$170K** two-year grant from the **Erb Family Foundation** for the development and execution of a Bilingual Lead Abatement Certification Program with our fiscal sponsor, Global Detroit, in partnership with the City of Detroit HRD. In July, we received an additional **\$135K** from the Gilbert Family Foundation.

As of March 2023, we have 108 lead participants, 81 lead certified and 100 are RRP certified.


